Community and University Place Standards/Rules

Sidewalks, Lighting and Safety News

Many of you have asked about why the City has not extended the sidewalks down 54^{th} St. As you may recall, the sidewalks installed about 2 years ago was a grant related to the proximity to the school. 54^{th} Street beyond 83^{rd} St. is not considered a first-tier street and the city will not install sidewalks.

The Board will be contacting the city to see if they can install signage at the curve on 54th Street and Academy Terrace to help drivers remember to slow down and watch for children.
